



## wine list

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### white wine

#### Castelbello Catarrato Sicilia 2009 – Italy

A dry white wine made from the indigenous Catarrato variety which has flavours not unlike Chardonnay, perhaps with a touch of spicy Viognier.

#### Cullian View Chenin Blanc 2009 – South Africa

South Africa's most popular grape variety, youthful, fruity character and a fresh, zesty acidity. Very well balanced.

#### Corte Vigna Pinot Grigio Provincia de Pavia 2008/09

Related to the Pinot Gris grape of Alsace, which in North West Italy produces a dry, lighter, more floral style, with racy, balanced fruit.

#### Vidal Sauvignon Blanc 2009 – New Zealand

Capsicum and gooseberry aromas lead into a palate that bursts with passionfruit and tropical fruit flavours. A lively natural acidity and crisp finish balance this mouthfilling wine.

### ro e wine

#### Castelbello Ro e Merlot del Veneto 2009 – Italy

On the nose this wine displays aromas of wild strawberries with delicate floral notes. The palate is lively, bursting with crisp red fruit flavours and a good persistent finish.

#### Don Jacobo Rioja Rosado 2008/09 – Spain

A delightfully deep coloured Ro e from spains premier wine region, with a fresh fruity nose and a crisp youthful palate.





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### red wine

#### Castelbello Red, Merlot del Veneto 2008 – Italy

Intense and full red colour with subtle violet nuances. It has a pleasant flavour and a full, well balanced taste.

#### Brookfield Reserve Shiraz Viognier 2008 – Australia

An elegant wine with a surprising nose that displays vivid spicy, peppery freshness as well as lovely black fruits. The palate has a spicy, ripe fruit but at the same time the Viognier adds zing.

#### Marques de Morano Rioja Tinto 2007 – Spain

A young Rioja made using the classic Tempranillo grape variety. Displays soft berry fruit on the finish.

#### Marie Louise Parisot Bourgogne Pinot Noir 2007 – France

A good example of a straight forward Pinot Noir selected from the vineyards in the Cote de Or. This wine is aged in pieces for nine months before bottling to help soften the ripe, velvety tannins.

### sparkling wine

#### Fantinel Prosecco Brut – Italy

A classic elegant Prosecco with tiny bubbles (the hall mark of quality) and a fresh green apple nose and palate, with a long crisp finish.

### champagne

#### Louis Dornier Brut – France

A champagne from the most southerly of the champagne vineyards which produce riper grapes that result in wines which are both softer in style and quicker to mature, making them perfect for drinking relatively young. A light, fresh, vigorously youthful champagne with a fine elegant, slightly lemony nose.

#### NV Taittinger, Brut Reserve – France

Crisp, citrusy aromas with subtle toasty notes lead to an elegant, balanced palate with a lively, mousse texture and a crisp, flavourful finish.

#### NV Taittinger, Prestige Ro e – France

Fresh aromas of wild strawberries and spice precede the balanced, smooth flavours of red fruits. This Ro e displays charm and a subtle harmony of flavours.
